“Legal Perspective of Cyberbullying, Sexting, and Use of Social Media”

Lori Chiu is the managing associate in the firm's San Diego area office. Ms. Chiu serves as an adjunct professor at the University of San Diego School of Law, where she previously earned her Juris Doctor degree.

She also chaired the USD Appellate Moot Court Board, competed in national moot court tournaments, and won second place in the Federal Bar Association Thurgood A. Marshall Memorial Moot Court Competition. She was awarded the Order of Barrister's Statue of Justice, and is a Permanent Member of the *San Diego International Law Journal*. Her legal writing includes publication of *Drawing the Line Between Competing Interests: Strengthening Online Data Privacy Protection in an Increasingly Networked World* (14 San Diego Int'l L.J. 281 (2013)). Prior to law school, she received a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science, with honors, from the University of California, Irvine.
