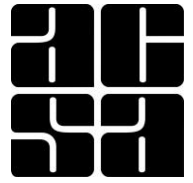

## ACSA REGION XVII ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES COMMITTEE CHAIRS / COUNCIL PRESIDENTS

ACSA Region 17 committees and councils are the local counterpart of State ACSA committees and councils. These committees/councils are very influential in the development of programs and legislation in Sacramento.

**Committees include:**

**The Roles and Responsibilities of a Committee Chair or Council President:**

- Attend all State meetings in Sacramento as scheduled by the State ACSA Chair or President (paid for by State ACSA).
- Distribute information and gather input for State meetings at meetings in the Region (OCDE, job-alike gatherings, etc.).
- Attend Region 17 Leadership Forum meetings two times each year. Leadership Forum is the Region’s legislative body. All chairs/presidents are delegates with voting rights and responsibilities on Region 17 issues and also provide input on State ACSA issues [previous issues have included ACSA’s \$1,000,000 liability insurance; dues rebates (funding that comes back to the Region from State ACSA dues); input asked of Regions by State ACSA regarding legislation; strategic planning process]. Delegates at Region Leadership Forums also conduct routine business for the Region, including approval of the Region budget and calendar.
- Act as liaisons between Region 17 and other governmental and/or professional agencies and organizations involved in public education.
- Encourage member networking opportunities sponsored by Region 17, including Region activities and events, professional development opportunities, ACSA/OCSBA joint dinner meetings, etc.
- Participate in and recommend activities designed to further the collegiality of Orange County administrators, promote membership, improve communication, and enhance participation in State and Region events and activities.
- Attend job-alike meetings at OCDE to share information from state meetings and gather feedback for the State. Committee Chairs/Council Presidents are given opportunities to report at these meetings. Please identify yourself to the Assistant Superintendent of Instruction for OCDE as an ACSA representative when you attend. This is a great opportunity to get your committee/council “on the map.”
